The official launch ceremony of the international year of chemistry in China has taken place in the People's Great Hall, Beijing, China on April 9. Madame Liu Yandong (State Councilor), Prof. Chunli Bai (President of Chinese Academy of Sciences), Madame Gu Xiulian (the former Vice Chairwoman of the People's Congress of China), Prof. Yao Jiannian (President of Chinese Chemical Society) and 730 attendees from Academic, University and School, and Industry, as well as UNESCO representatives attended the event.

4) Launch of popularization activities for IYC2011 in China

8) “Joy and Music in Chemistry” Concert

A special concert named “Joy and Music in Chemistry” is held in National Centre for Performing Art, Beijing on May 24. This is a very unique activity for celebrating the International Year of Chemistry in China. Prof. Qifeng Zhou (Vice President of CCS, President of Peking University, Professor of Chemistry) initiated this concert and wrote a themed lyrics “Song of Chemistry” for a chorus. The concert has been performed by 6 student groups from Peking University.

All of symposia sponsored by Chinese Chemical Society have been preceded by “International Year of Chemistry in China”. It will promote IYC 2011.


12) “Reading for understanding Chemistry”

13) “TYC in China Symposium on Frontiers of Chemistry” & “50 Years of Angewandte Chemie Celebration”, Beijing, June 22, 2011.

A one-day symposium is organized in the campus of Tsinghua University by the Chinese Chemical Society and German Chemical Society as well as the Angew Chem Editorials. 9 prominent chemists present their perspectives on the advances in chemical sciences. They are Hartmut Michel (Chemistry Nobel Prize 1988, Max-Planck Institute for Biophysics), Ryoji Noyori (Chemistry Nobel Prize 2001, Riken), Barry Sharpless (Chemistry Nobel Prize 2001, Scripps Institute San Diego), Helmut Schwarz (Chairman of Humboldt Foundation, Tech Univ Berlin), François Diederich (Chairman of Editorial Board of Angew. Chem., ETH), Alois Fuerstner (Max-Planck Institute for Carbon Chemistry), Qilin Zhou (Nankai University), Xi Zhang (Tsinghua University), and Zhen Yang (Peking University). More than 400 attended the symposium and more than 2000 watched the internet broad cast.
